

Supplemental Instruction

What is Supplemental Instruction (SI)?

- A non-remedial academic support program for students
- Consists of regularly scheduled, voluntary, out-of-class SI study sessions, facilitated by a trained peer leader or SI Leader who utilizes collaborative and engaging activities to help students learn and understand a course's material
- Targets historically difficult classes
- Overseen by an ALTC Program Coordinator

What exactly are SI Sessions?

- Free and voluntary study sessions
- A place to review course material and practice problems
- SI Leaders clarify difficult concepts or problems and answer students' questions
- SI Sessions are NOT lectures, lessons on new material, or exam/study cram sessions

What are the benefits of SI and of being a SI Leader?

- Improved course grades (when a student attends five or more sessions)
- Professors receive help and are better in tune with their students and the pulse of the class
- An increase in class retention rates
- Sessions are free and open to all students
- SI Leaders are paid
- SI Leaders build better relationships with their professor

Who are SI Leaders?

- Tulane undergraduate or graduate students
- Peer leaders who guide and support students in learning concepts and problems
- Students that have already taken the prospective SI course at Tulane and received an "A"
- Students that maintain an overall GPA of 3.2
- They are NOT Teaching Assistants - they do NOT run or grade labs; grade any quizzes, tests, exams or share quizzes or tests
